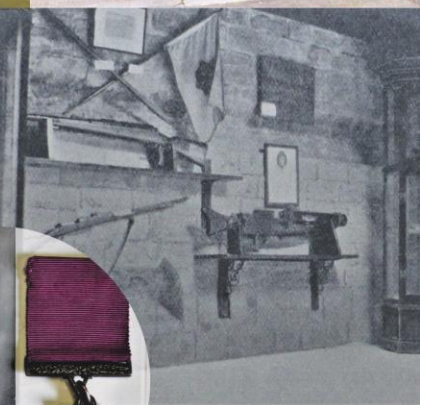
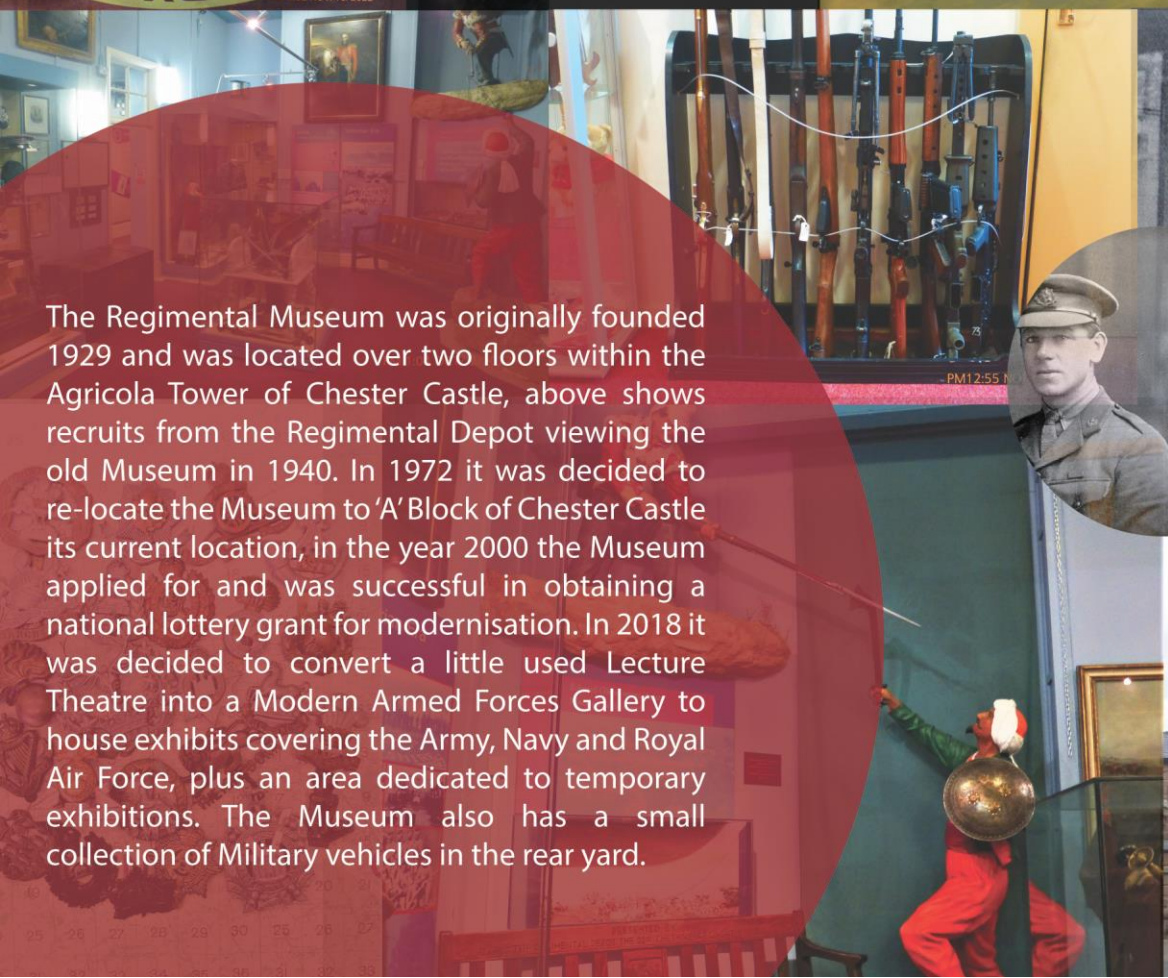

The Regimental Museum was originally founded 1929 and was located over two floors within the Agrícola Tower of Chester Castle, above shows recruits from the Regimental Depot viewing the old Museum in 1940. In 1972 it was decided to re-locate the Museum to 'A' Block of Chester Castle its current location, in the year 2000 the Museum applied for and was successful in obtaining a national lottery grant for modernisation. In 2018 it was decided to convert a little used Lecture Theatre into a Modern Armed Forces Gallery to house exhibits covering the Army, Navy and Royal Air Force, plus an area dedicated to temporary exhibitions. The Museum also has a small collection of Military vehicles in the rear yard.
